History of The Family Center

In 2002, <u>The Community Foundation</u> celebrated its 10-year anniversary. The board dreamed of celebrating by making a notable impact in the way human services were delivered in Hancock County. Many local agencies were struggling with an increased demand for services, reduced funding, and inadequate facilities, which hindered them in effectively providing services to individuals and families.

A separate organization called <u>Hancock Properties Foundation</u> was formed as an extension of The Community Foundation to manage The Family Center and other real estate. The Board purchased a vacant grocery store in May 2005 and planning for The Family Center began.


The Family Center opened its doors May 1, 2006 with 17 agencies housed in the building. 10 of the original agencies remain. Since then, several agencies have outgrown The Family Center and the building has been renovated to meet the changing needs of tenant agencies.




